## Update on the Household Support Fund

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*Please see information below received from Cheshire East.*

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On 6 March 2024 the Chancellor of the Exchequer, Rt Hon Jeremy Hunt MP, presented his Spring Budget to Parliament. The Chancellor confirmed that the Household Support Fund (HSF) is extended for a further six months from 01 April 2024 to 30 September 2024.

The current funding and support package ends on 31 March 2024. Now that we have confirmation of the HSF continued funding, we are awaiting the HSF eligibility guidance and grant conditions from the Department for Work and Pensions. Once these have been received, we will work at pace to design what the future HSF support package will look like, ensuring that it goes to those most in need. As a result, there will be no vouchers issued prior to the Easter school holidays.
