- HK opened the meeting, welcomed everyone and thanked them for coming
- The minutes of the last meeting were reviewed and confirmed as an accurate record of the meeting held on Thursday 14th March 2024.

Finances

- **Bank account:** It was agreed again that previous members of the committee who have since left (L Dennis & J Colclough) be removed as signatories of the FOS bank account. It was approved by the committee that the new signatories would be C Fearn (Treasurer) and H Knight (Chairperson) and that once the signatories had been changed, we will be able to order a debit card for purchasing from the account and access online banking (HK & CF to co-ordinate).
- **Donations received:** The Tesco Stronger Starts grant that we applied for (£500) has been deposited in the bank account, we have also received almost £200 in donations from friends of the Knight Family in cash which has been put into the cash we currently hold and the school lottery continues to be making good money for us.
- Bank balance: Currently stands at £20,269.14 at the statement dated April 5th.
- **Cash in hand:** We have also counted the cash we currently hold which stands at £1,825.50 this will be paid into the bank account immediately with £425.50 held for petty cash and event floats.
- **Requests:** As soon as we get the debit card for the account, we will purchase the agreed equipment from the outstanding requests. There are no more requests at this point. All staff have access to the request form and the group agreed that the Leadership Team would refer classes to us when needs for equipment etc arise.
